

Restriction of the use of certain Hazardous Substances in electrical and electronic equipment (RoHS)

As a sub-contract manufacturer, performing build to print activities, Scott Cables Ltd rely on the organisations who design the products that we manufacture (typically our customers) to determine RoHS compliance requirements that apply to the products and ensure that all technical data and component selections made during design are appropriate and compliant. Requirements for RoHS compliance / exemption must be determined by our customers / design organisations as Scott Cables Ltd will often be unaware of the end application of the products that we manufacture. Further to this, Scott Cables Ltd rely on customer / design organization supplied technical data to identify any applicable part markings that relate to RoHS (eg: CE). Additionally, Scott Cables Ltd would not usually raise Declarations of Conformity to RoHS unless agreed in advance with customers and arrangements / requirements confirmed.

Scott Cables Ltd source components / materials in accordance with the technical data supplied by design organisations (typically our customers). Unless identified otherwise, Scott Cables Ltd work on the basis that all components / materials required for products that we build are to be compliant with the latest RoHS Directive and amendments. To this extent, all Purchase Orders placed on suppliers clearly state the need for RoHS compliance.

Scott Cables Ltd will only seek to gain specific evidence of component / material compliance with RoHS when contractually requested and agreed with our customers. Due to the diversity of our customer base and end applications, Scott Cables Ltd are unable to offer company wide statements of RoHS compliance.
