

Conflict Minerals Statement



With reference to the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act, Section 1502 Conflict Minerals, Scott Cables Limited can confirm the Company is:

- a) *Fully aware of its responsibilities under the Act.*
b) *Fully aware of our suppliers obligations under the Act and take appropriate action to determine that suppliers do not supply the following raw materials which originate from the Democratic Republic of Congo.*

- *Gold (Au)*
- *Columbite-tantalite (or coltan, the colloquial African term) is the metal ore from which the element Tantalum is extracted (Ta).*
- *Wolframite (an important source of the element Tungsten (W))*
- *Cassiterite (the chief ore needed to produce Tin (Sn))*

These are sometimes referred to as “the 3T’s and gold”, 3TG, or even simply the “3T’s”.

Under the US Conflict Material Law, additional minerals may be added to this list in the future.

- c) *Committed to fully disclose and comply with any reporting requirements.*
